Lake Livingston Dam Observation Gazebo

This observation Gazebo is maintained and policed by the TRA. It is handicapped accessible. It offers a great view of the discharge side of the dam and the spillway. Many water birds (usually hundreds of pelicans, cormorants, and egrets) along with swallows and indigenous songbirds can be seen at any time of the day. The FM 3288 bridge crosses the river just below the dam. The upstream view from this bridge is a magnificent, huge vista like no other in the area.

Directions

From the Polk County Courthouse (Intersection of Hwy 59 Business and Hwy 190)

Go South 12.5 miles on Hwy 59 to FM 1988; Turn right (West); Drive 3.3 miles; Turn right on FM 5 just past the entrance of the TRA; drive .5 miles; gazebo and parking is on right.
